## FRESHMAN ORIENTATION

Freshman Orientation is an opportunity for our incoming students to become acclimated to the school. Upon arrival, students will report to the Performing Arts Center to gather officially for the first time as the Class of 2020. They will be introduced to a number of people who will play important roles in their lives over the next four years at the Hills, and they will learn about opportunities available to them as they begin their high school careers. Students then will report to designated classrooms where they will receive their schedules and hear from our peer leaders, who will address the typical concerns of incoming students, including the following questions:

- How does the rotating drop schedule work?
- How do I locate and open my locker?
- How do I find my classes?

Students will have the chance to ask questions and address any concerns they may have. They then will follow an abbreviated eight-period schedule, allowing them to find their classrooms and meet their teachers. Peer leaders and teachers will be in the hallways to assist with directions.

Bus transportation will be provided to and from the program. Students will receive information about their bus stop location and the regular pick-up time, which will be the same for this orientation.
